Library Behavior Policies

Students should practice the same behaviors they are accustomed to in their regular classrooms.

- Raising hands to speak or ask questions during lessons
- Use inside voices during group work and book selection
- Walking during any transitions
- Use respectful tone and words towards others
- Keep hands and feet to yourself

Students who do not adhere to the library behavior policies will have their responsibility grades affected and may face the following consequences (in no particular order):

- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) notification
- Principal notification
